



Equipment required for a 'campsite'



To correspond to the 'campsite' category, you have to fulfil the following obligations as regards equipment, among others. To check which accommodation category you belong to and find out about the other obligations to be fulfilled in order to register your tourist accommodation, use the assistant on www.economie-emploi.brussels.

SITE

- The campsite is located in a healthy place.
- The site is supervised whenever open by one person (the operator or the person in charge of the day-to-day management) who can be reached at all times.
- The campsite has:
 - waste collection equipment that is operational at all times, comprising either dustbins with lids or plastic bags or closed containers;
 - an internal, enclosed sewerage system to which at least the collective bathroom installations are connected and which is itself connected to the public sewerage network;
 - a drinking water supply mechanism.
- This drinking water supply mechanism:
 - is designed so that the water distributed cannot be polluted;
 - provides a minimum daily flow of one hundred litres per plot;
 - comprises at least one water point area in hard materials per group or part of a group of fifteen plots where waste water can be discharged.
- The use of non-drinking water is permitted only for the operation of the toilets, dumping for chemical toilets and cleaning purposes. The distribution of non-drinking water is very clearly indicated.

BATHROOM FACILITIES

- The campsite has bathroom facilities for collective use in one or more closed and covered structures.
- The number of bathroom facilities is equally divided between men and women.
- The sections and separate entrances for men and women are indicated by a clearly visible pictogram.
- These bathroom facilities contain at least:
 - per group or part of a group of ten plots:*
 - a toilet equipped with a seat with rim and flush and a washbasin with a mirror and a shelf;
 - a urinal with flush;
 - a shower with hot and cold running drinking water;

per bathroom block:

- a waste outlet for chemical toilets.
- The collective bathroom facilities are well maintained and have an efficient ventilation system.
- The bathroom facilities accessible during the night have electric lighting.
